

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN
NORTHWESTERN STATE UNIVERSITY OF LOUISIANA
AND
SOUTHERN UNIVERSITY at SHREVEPORT**

Northwestern State University of Louisiana (NSULA) and Southern University at Shreveport (SUSLA) have agreed to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding for a 2 + 2 program between the two institutions. The 2 + 2 program will allow graduates from SUSLA Associate of Science in Nursing (ASN) program to complete the first two years of study at SUSLA and transfer all credit hours as designated in Appendix A to NSULA for completion of the Bachelors of Science in Nursing (BSN). Students transferring to NSULA may complete the last two years of their course work at NSULA. Both institutions serve constituency needs and are responsive, student oriented institutions that prepare students to become productive members of society as well as promote the academic development and improvement in the quality of life of citizens in their regions.

This partnership is mutually beneficial to both institutions for several reasons:

- SUSLA traditional and non-traditional students will have the opportunity after completing core requirements at SUSLA to transfer to an accredited BSN program that will accept SUSLA credits.
- NSULA will have the opportunity to accept SUSLA ASN graduates into the BSN Program who are well prepared with foundation course work.
- Both the University and the College are accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (SACSCOC).
- Both the University and the College have full-time faculty with advanced academic and professional credentials and both have support resources (i.e., library, internet access and adequate administrative-faculty-staff backup).

In accordance with this Memorandum of Understanding, Southern University at Shreveport agrees to:


- Provide academic advising to students who plan to transfer to NSULA according to agreements in Appendix A.
- Have ASN students who intend to transfer to NSULA sign the Intent to Transfer form and mail the completed form (Appendix B) to NSULA: RN-BSN Director, 1800 Line Ave, Shreveport, LA 71101.
- Provide students the opportunity to obtain the SUSLA credit hours as listed in Appendix A of the Memorandum of Understanding between NSULA and SUSLA.
- Provide transferring students assistance in completing the NSULA Application for Admission into the Bachelor of Science Nursing Program.
- Provide information about the 2 + 2 Agreement in the Southern University Shreveport General Catalog.
- Jointly market the 2 + 2 agreement with NSULA.

In accordance with this Memorandum of Understanding, Northwestern State University agrees to:

- Provide consultation to SUSLA regarding required content for the two introductory nursing courses.
- Receive and maintain "Intent to Transfer" forms from SUSLA students and honor the agreement regarding academic catalog in effect on the date of the student's signature and the NSULA confirmation signature. (Appendix B).
- Accept Southern University at Shreveport credit hours as listed in Appendix A of the Memorandum of Understanding between NSULA and SUSLA.
- Provide SUSLA with copies of the Application for Admission into the Bachelor of Science Nursing Program and other advising materials.
- Provide information about the 2 + 2 Agreement in the Northwestern State University of Louisiana catalog.
- Jointly market the 2 + 2 agreement.

By signature of Dr. James B. Henderson, President Northwestern State University and signature of Sam Gilliam, Chancellor Southern University at Shreveport, this 2 + 2 Memorandum of Understanding is entered into on the _____ of _____ 2016.

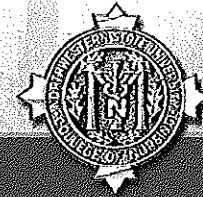
