

BI-LATERAL TRANSFER SERVICES AGREEMENT
For the Online Bachelor of Science Degree in Criminal Justice

This bi-lateral transfer services agreement is entered into between Southern University and A&M College and Southern University at Shreveport, Louisiana for the purpose of providing educational access to students in the Southern University System.

Southern University and A&M College (hereafter "SUBR") welcomes qualified transfer students from the Associate of Applied Science (AAS) in Criminal Justice Administration degree program from Southern University – Shreveport (hereafter "SUSLA") for completion of the Bachelor of Science Degree in Criminal Justice, to include the fully online degree program and the traditional degree program. Credit for AAS coursework completed at SUSLA will transfer and be accepted by the Department of Criminal Justice at SUBR as detailed below in Appendix A: SUSLA AAS Degree to SUBR BS Degree Criminal Justice Program Plan.

Transferability of Course Work Completed at SUSLA

Students completing the AAS degree in Criminal Justice Administration at SUSLA who intend to transfer to the Bachelor of Science degree in Criminal Justice at SUBR will be awarded transfer credit as follows:

1. Thirty-seven (37) hours of General Education credit, and up to thirty-three (33) hours of technical education credits will be accepted into the B.S. degree as indicated on the Program Plan.
2. A minimum of 120 hours of credit is required to earn the Bachelor of Science degree from Southern University at Baton Rouge. The final 30 semester hours of course credit must be completed in residence at SUBR.

3. Transfer students must satisfy all SUBR additional GE requirements to earn the BS degree. Those additional requirements are set forth in the Program Plan, which is attached and incorporated herein.
4. The courses offered at SUSLA listed on the attached Program Plan will partially fulfill SUBR's GE requirements, as indicated, if the grade earned is C or better.
5. Students intent on transferring into the B.S. Degree in Criminal Justice major from SUSLA's Criminal Justice Administration AAS degree must follow the prescribed Program Plan to receive articulated credit.
6. Students who did not complete an A.A.S. degree at SUSLA are not guaranteed the benefits of this agreement.
7. Transfer admission criteria for SUBR's Department of Criminal Justice can be found in the SUBR Catalog located at the University's website.
8. This agreement shall be valid for 4 years from the date of signing but is subject to review upon changes and updates to the Criminal Justice curricula, and catalogs at both institutions

This Transfer Services Agreement shall be effective upon execution by the Chief Academic Officer at each institution
